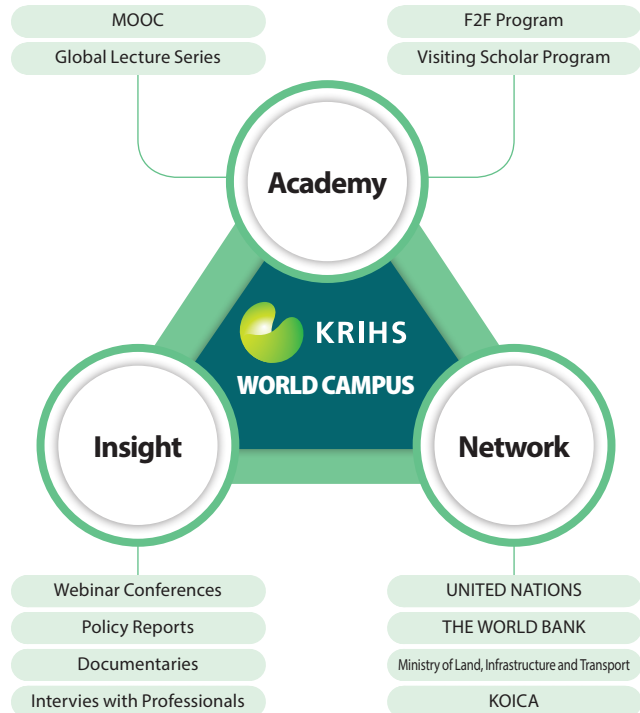


This program will explore the past and current efforts to develop policies and give prescriptive advice on how to plan, implement and evaluate its targeted programs

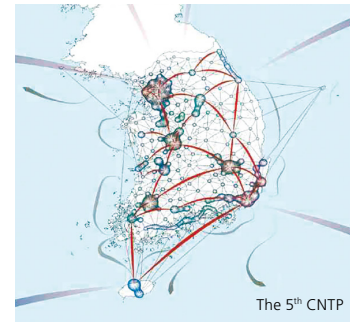

COMPREHENSIVE NATIONAL TERRITORIAL PLAN

Korea's Comprehensive National Territorial Plan(CNTP) is the highest level of national territorial plan that presents the long-term direction of national land development. The CNTP is the basis of the plans at the provincial, city, and country levels. The 1st CNTP was formulated in 1972 and the 5th CNTP (2020-2040) was recently established. The 5th CNTP aims for responding to new mega-trends and external conditions such as low fertility, aging population, the 4th industrial revolution, climate change, and inter-Korean relations.

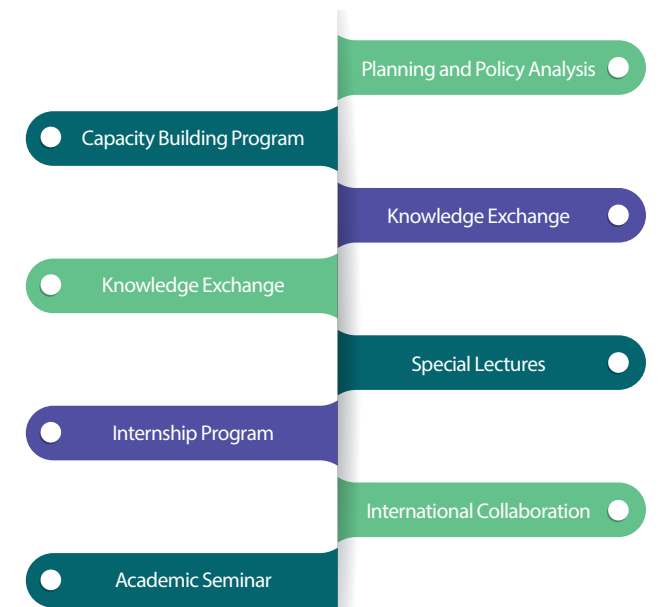




